Policy, Plan and Program What is Policy? Policy is a statement of goals.—Quality Education for all. A policy contains one or more plans to attain the policy's goals—Increasing school enrollment, reducing drop outs, increasing rate of passing in Completion Exam, etc. Each plan specifies objectives to be attained through a program Program is a set of specific actions--- Stipend program, school feeding program, etc.
