Introduce yourself as "the conflict" from the previous scenario in Lesson One. Each student is a member of the scenario's basketball team. Ask them to think about how comfortable they are with this conflict, and direct them to stand in relation to their comfort level with the conflict (without students leaving the room).

Write down their different answers on the flip chart and discuss how the youth feel about the conflict.

- If your child has a conflict with a sibling or friend, call “time out” so they can cool off. Then go through the steps of conflict resolution with them and remind them of the rules.
- Ask your child to explain the difference between “I-messages” and “blaming” messages. Try to use “I-messages” as often as possible and avoid “blaming” messages.
